New Business

- Treasurer Report -
 - All dues were paid except one homeowner McWilliams.
 - o Returned check charges will be handled by Brendan
 - Operating account \$81069
 - o Reserve account \$28,006
 - o HOA has outstanding invoices for landscaping from prior season
 - Delinquent homeowner was referred to accountant for collection. Accountant needs more information.
 Additional information and images to refer to collections.
 - o Sara, Accountant will advise us how to best handle \$26498. May need to open a second account.

Old Business

- Wallner Project
 - o Homeowner never signed the agreement to maintain tie wall. Work was done but not the paperwork.
 - Construction trailer was removed when requested. No construction vehicles can be parked overnight.
 - Board discussed recourse for Wallner tie wall Since homeowner requested the work and did not sign
 the agreement, HOA BOD will hold homeowner to maintenance agreement since it was required to get
 approval for the work.
- Merefish and Hurwitz Driveway
 - Plumbing for heated driveway is installed but the concrete promised was not available to the contractor.
 This was not communicated to the Hurwitz.
 - o Pour date for concrete is after mid-January.
- Parking Signs
 - Plow contractor does not like some of the sign placement. May need to move a few.
 - Construction workers do not oblige.
- Rockwell drain
 - o Reid spoke to homeowner
 - Reid pulled the permit for construction and learned the prior homeowner had the drain on the permit as part of construction.
 - o Consensus of the HOA BOD is this is not a HOA issue. Prior owner improved this area which reverts the responsibility to the homeowner.
- Landscaping
 - o Nothing new
- 1170 A Construction start
 - Unknown no new information
- Other issues
 - Hibachi and front loader were removed from Casolar.

- o Mike Bailey will prepare a letter to all homeowners involved in renting. They will discuss.
- o Homestake water break resulted in landscaping and vegetation being removed. Will need to discuss
- Bigsby email HOA handled many issues this year. New construction policy seems to be making a difference.
- Wallner bond amount of \$4000 is in the operating account.
