New Business

1141 Casolar - Wallner Project

Description of the current state of the construction. Large deep hole on the North East side of Wallner's property. During Labor Day the hole was exposed and not fenced on HOA's property. HOA needs to ensure all safety protocol are being followed for contractors and we expressed concerns that trench box is in place for safety as well. Possible expansion of the project to include a new roof line or roof extension over HOA property was mentioned. Also address re-vegetation of original planting (sod) with homeowner once project is done.

Egress window well approved by HOA BOD for Wallner.

Brandon to connect with homeowner and contractor about scope of the project. Addressing safety on HOA ground, TOV DRB, roof extension, and any other additional changes.

Currently, HOA has irrigation controls in Jack Wallner's garage. Irrigation equipment will be adjusted then reinstalled in the garage. Brandon to follow-up. Blow out for irrigation is also in this location.

Idea to run frost free line to back of house was suggested. Nancy to follow-up with Water Company

Reid addressed cottonwood associated with 1148 Sandstone properties near Pierce's which is overgrown. The landscape architect mentioned this tree last week. She recommended that it be removed. BOD discussion of either to trim or remove. Brandon to reach out the Pierce's to advise them of our discussion.

The 2 trees discussed at Annual meeting near Curtiss property have not been removed due to parked cars. Arrange time that Ceres can finish the work.
